



County of Haliburton Notice of Public Meeting Concerning an Application for Consent

Take notice that the County of Haliburton Land Division Committee has received an application for consent to create an easement for right-of-way.

Location: The lands to be severed are located at 1343 True North Road (Part Lot 6, Concession 10, Geographic Township of Dudley), located in the Municipality of Dysart et al (see key map).

Purpose and Effect: The application proposes to create an easement for right-of-way.

Public Meeting: The County of Haliburton Land Division Committee will be holding a public meeting as required under the Planning Act. The public meeting is an opportunity for the Committee to hear and consider comments related to the proposed consent. Any member of the public may speak in favour of or in opposition to the application during the public meeting.

Appeals: If a person or public body has the ability to appeal the decision of the Haliburton County Land Division Committee in respect of the proposed consent to the Ontario Land Tribunal but does not make written submissions to the Land Division Committee before it gives or refuses to give provisional consent, the Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.
